REQUIREMENTS FOR ONE ACADEMIC CREDIT FROM CSUEB:

In order to receive one unit of credit, CSUEB requires a minimum of ten hours of work and a written paper. The one-day session will be eight hours and you will need to write a paper – which should take you about two hours – based on the course content.

The paper (typed) is due TWO WEEKS after the class in which you were enrolled.

- 1) Head your paper with your name, address, phone number, grade level(s) taught, school, school district and the Educators Academy course title. (If you are a non-formal or unaccredited teacher, please give your job title, a brief job description and name of your company/agency).
- 2) Limit your paper to two pages, highlighting the lesson(s) you will do with your students based on something you learned in the Educators Academy session.
- 3) Your paper will discuss how you have used Coast Alive! materials in your classroom and what your students have learned from it. A successful paper will include:
 - a. The name of your activity and its purpose
 - b. How the activity you learned while participating in the Educators Academy changed or enhanced what you teach
 - c. Whether or not the content of this course fits into an already existing curriculum in your classroom or if you will design a new unit(s) on this topic
 - d. Your final recommendations
- 4) In your paper, be sure it is clear where you are fitting in new material so that there is a distinction between what existed prior to this session.
